Container pricing, how it works

When you are ready to order we will provide you with a quotation which will usually be valid for 30 days.

Container pricing is very competitive so can fluctuate dependent on freight costs, exchange rates etc.

Once we have accepted your order the net price of the goods is fixed for you.



What's included in the price?

Our prices are in £ sterling and include delivery to your central warehouse.

How do I place an order?

Using an excel spreadsheet you can easily calculate the desired container fill, our agents will be happy to assist with this, if you wish. Once received, our office will confirm the order and advise of any minor adjustments required to optimise the space available.

A 20' container is approximately 29m³ and a 40' high cube approximately 68m³.

Value will vary considerably dependent on the products chosen.

How do I pay?

There is a 20% deposit required with the order, orders cannot be scheduled for production until the deposit is received. The balance is due about 10 days before delivery.

Container options

There are 2 container options. Your price quote is based on a 40' high cube container. However you can choose a 20' container which carries a £500 surcharge. The surcharge covers the increased costs of transporting the goods from the factory to port and then from port to you.

How long does delivery take?

Usually we suggest you allow 8 weeks for production and 6 weeks for shipping, this will be confirmed at time of ordering.

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Greater product mix

You can select up to 8 products per container. Your order can be mixed across 2 ranges. Minimum of any item is just 50.
Shelving minimum order quantity of 500 units.
